IMPLEMENTATION AND SOURCE GUIDE

This is a school-level weekly scheme derived from NaCCA's official 2019 Standards-Based Curricula for Upper Primary (Basic 4-Basic 6). NaCCA provides the content standards, indicators and exemplars; this document distributes the Basic 4 scope across three 12-week school terms.

Each term has Weeks 1-10 for teaching/application, Week 11 for revision and targeted remediation, and Week 12 for end-of-term assessment, correction and feedback.

Where a week combines several official indicators, a curriculum-family reference such as B4.1.*.* or MULTI B4.* is used rather than inventing a false single indicator. Teachers should consult the full NaCCA curriculum for the complete official exemplar wording when preparing lesson plans.

English Language is organised so Oral Language, Reading, Grammar, Writing/Conventions and Extensive Reading are represented every week.

OWOP is included as a separate subject because it was requested and because NaCCA still hosts the official B4-B6 OWOP curriculum. NaCCA's current curriculum page notes that from the 2024/2025 academic year OWOP content is to be accommodated in related Primary subjects rather than operating as a separate Primary module; schools should therefore align timetabling with current NaCCA/GES directions.

Core competency abbreviations used: CP = Critical Thinking and Problem Solving; CC = Communication and Collaboration; CI = Creativity and Innovation; PL = Personal Development and Leadership; DL = Digital Literacy; CG = Cultural Identity and Global Citizenship.
